Interior

- Gorgeous Chef's kitchen was recently remodeled and includes a Butler's Pantry for added convenience
- Features include granite counters, Viking appliances throughout, gorgeous tongue and groove white painted wood ceilings, two dishwashers, and two farm sinks
- The 48" Viking gas range sits center stage with double ovens, six burners, a griddle, and a pot filler
- A 27" Sub Zero refrigerator/freezer blends in seamlessly with the custom cabinetry
- The Butler's Pantry will not be outdone with a 48" side-by-side built-in Viking refrigerator and freezer, a Viking wine cooler with a 150-bottle capacity, and finally, stunning glass-fronted cabinets for china or cookbooks
- Architecturally designed pendant lighting accents the granite-topped island where guests are sure to gather

- Kitchen nook area with views of the front areas of the property. A formal dining area with surrounding windows and French doors offers views of the backyard
- Slate flooring covers most of the home with radiant heating in some locations
- You will be in awe of the tongue-and-groove craftsmanship on walls and ceilings found throughout
- Two cozy sitting areas to enjoy a good book or take in views of the property
- A free-standing NORSE wood-burning stove adds an option for heating the home









- The first-floor guest room suite has a stunning bathroom that features radiant heat tile floors, glass tiles, a large walk-in shower with a block glass wall and pebble floor, and a large jetted soaking tub. This shower even has a faucet designed for dog washing if desired!
- A separate TV room/den can be found next to the guest suite with a beautiful glass block wall
- This country estate wouldn't be complete without a large Mudroom/Laundry Room that provides handy access to the backyard and horse stable - farm sink and ample storage with floor-to-ceiling cabinets







- Upstairs features another primary loft suite with carpet floors, an office area, a small balcony with views of the front of the property
- Its en-suite bath is simply exquisite with a huge walk-in shower with a block glass wall, a large freestanding tub, radiant heat tile floors, and two separate sink and vanity stations
- There are two separate primary closets with full closet organizers in each, sliding glass doors, and a separate TV/office area in the middle with a small refrigerator, TV, and cabinets.
- The upstairs exercise room has cork floors, an automatic skylight, lots of windows, and a door to the back deck and exterior staircase
- There is a bonus room off the exercise room that is fully insulated with automatic skylights currently used for storage



UC Davis Ranks First in the Nation in Veterinary Science

The University of California, Davis, School of Veterinary Medicine is ranked number one in the United States for the fifth year in a row in the annual 2019 QS World University subject rankings. The rankings, released Feb. 26, placed the school second globally in Veterinary Science.

"The continued recognition of UC Davis as a world leader in veterinary sciences is a tribute to our outstanding people and programs that advance the health of animals, people, and our planet," said the school's dean, Michael D. Lairmore.

The rankings are prepared by Quacquarelli Symonds, which is considered to be one of the most-widely referenced rankings agencies in the world. The veterinary ranking examines four indicators including academic reputation, reputation with employers, citations per paper, and productivity and impact of professors through a common metric called the h-index.

The school has shaped the field of veterinary medicine, developing dynamic veterinary treatments and making key discoveries related to animal, human and environmental health. Experts in dozens of scientific disciplines train future veterinarians and mentor leaders in veterinary practice, education, public health/food safety, research, environmental protection and biotechnology. The school operates a hospital in Davis that treats more than 50K animals a year and has operations in San Diego and Tulare California, the San Juan Islands in Washington, and in central Africa, as well as researchers working in California and across the globe.
